Clandestine Laboratory Safety Certification Medical Clearance

Pursuant to 29 CFR 1910-120, medical examinations are required for work in a hazardous waste environment and shall include a medical and work history of the patient with special emphasis on symptoms related to the handling of hazardous substances, health hazards, and the ability to wear personal protective equipment under extreme conditions.

Personnel who work at clandestine drug laboratories are likely to wear the following types of personal protective equipment:

- Air purifying respirator/self-contained breathing apparatus
- Plastic coated tyvek suit (saranex)
- Nitrile rubber gloves
- Latex rubber boot covers
